### **About Matthew Fritz**

Founded by vintner and entrepreneur Matthew Bonanno, Matthew Fritz is the companion wines to his Napa Valley flagship, BonAnno Cabernet Sauvignon. Matthew Fritz was founded on a few simple principles; seek out and source from top North Coast vineyards, let the fruit stand on its own through a pure, clean winemaking process, and ultimately, ensure every bottle of Matthew Fritz is a true representation of both the variety and appellation.

### **Vintage**

The 2022 harvest is expected to be very high quality across all of California. Due to the ongoing drought conditions, yields were again slightly lower. The year was not without challenges, but we expect this vintage to produce memorable wines of great concentration and complexity.

### **Vineyards**

Our Chardonnay grapes are sourced from some of the finest vineyards within Monterey County.

### **Winemaker**

Renowned winemaker, Jim Milone, crafts, blends and bottles Matthew Fritz in Healdsburg, Sonoma County. Jim grew up in the vineyards of his grandfather's winery in Mendocino County and currently lives in Northern Sonoma. His excellent relationships with wineries and growers throughout California are invaluable to our vineyard sourcing.

### **Tasting Notes**

The wine is lively and fresh with aromas of apple blossom, fresh citrus and peaches. The palate is textured with ripe peaches, pineapple and faint hints of vanilla
