Vintage

The 2023 was a late, relatively cool growing season, resulting in a great-quality year for Sauvignon Blanc with an excellent, above average crop.

Vineyards

Our 2023 Sauvignon Blanc is sourced some some of the finest vineyards in the Lake County AVA.

Winemaker

Renowned winemaker, Jim Milone, crafts, blends and bottles Matthew Fritz in Healdsburg, Sonoma County. Jim grew up in the vineyards of his grandfather's winery in Mendocino County and currently lives in Northern Sonoma. His excellent relationships with wineries and growers throughout California are invaluable to our vineyard sourcing.

Tasting Notes

The wine is a pale straw color. Tropical fruit aromas lead to citrus zest, crisp granny smith apples and faint floral notes. The palate is bright with a crisp and refreshing finish.
