Vintage

The 2023 wines are showing lower alcohol levels, good balance and high quality. Monterey County growers described the 2023 vintage as exceptional, with fruit that stood out for its harmonious balance of sugar and acidity.

Our Chardonnay grapes are sourced from some of the finest vineyards within Monterey County.

Winemaker

Renowned winemaker, Jim Milone, crafts, blends and bottles Matthew Fritz in Healdsburg, Sonoma County. Jim grew up in the vineyards of his grandfather's winery in Mendocino County and currently lives in Northern Sonoma. His excellent relationships with wineries and growers throughout California are invaluable to our vineyard sourcing.

Tasting Notes

The wine is crisp and fresh with aromas of orchard blossoms, fresh citrus and peaches. The palate is textured with ripe pineapple and hints of vanilla
